Welcome to our monthly edition of Monkey Puzzle Stafford news!

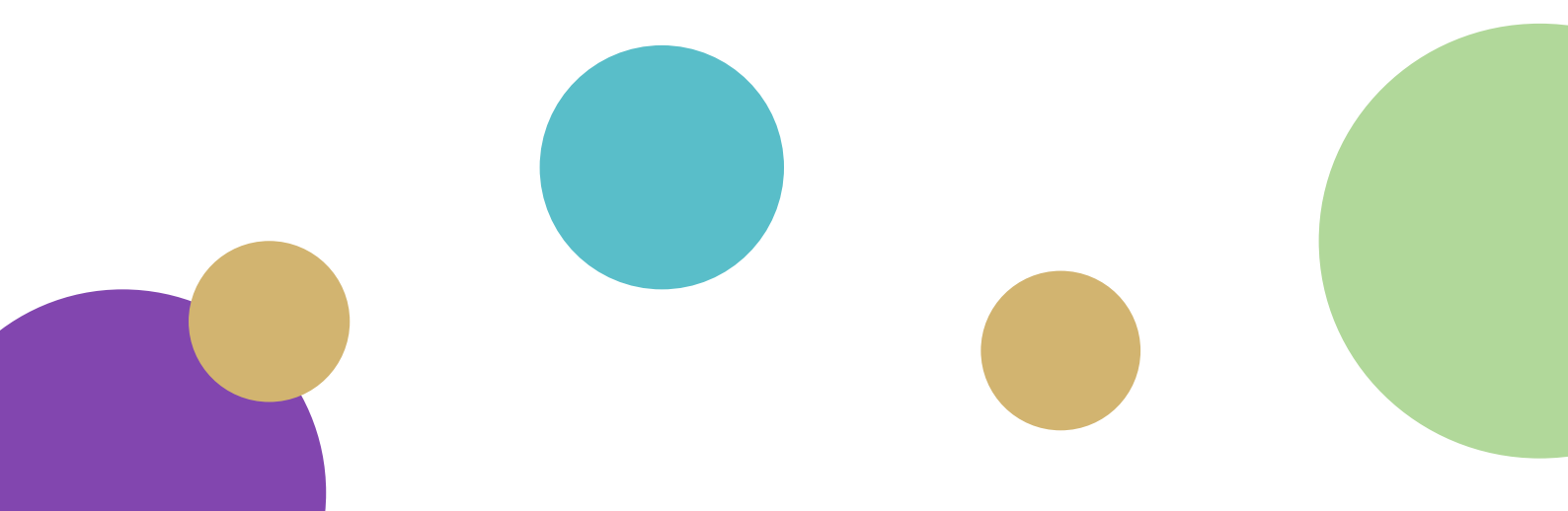
So, what have we been up to in October?



October has sure been a busy month for the Monkey Puzzle Family!

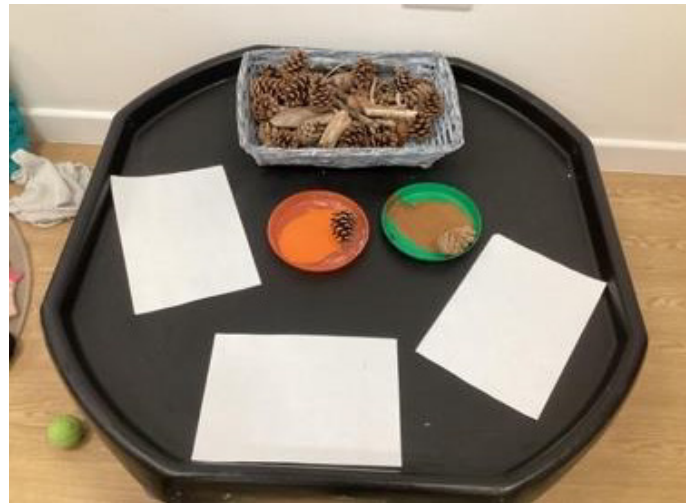

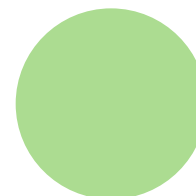


Cheeky Chimps

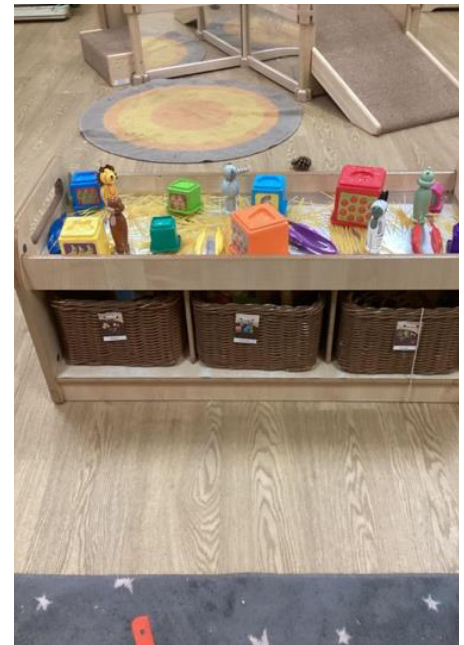

Happy Birthday!

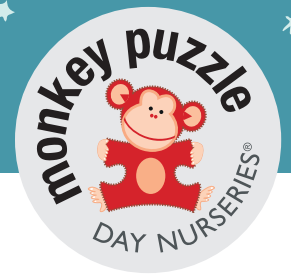
We have been celebrating lots of birthdays in October across the nursery. Happy Birthday to Ethan, Jack B, Jaxon, Maya and Latrelle!

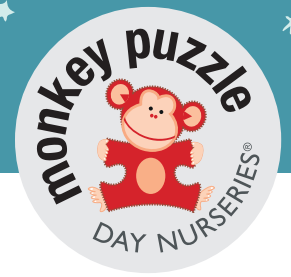
