Mischievous Monkeys

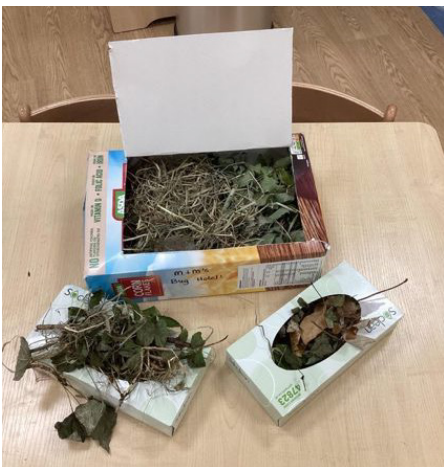

Well done Amy!

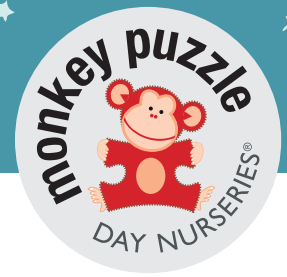


Staff Departure
