During Children's Mental Health week the baby room looked at emotions- in particular the emotion spoons that the staff have developed. These have been used during morning and afternoon circle time to help the babies express their feelings.

Our toddlers have carried on with activities linked to last month's topic 'the very hungry caterpillar! They have made their own caterpillars with paper plates and enjoyed painting these with our new paint pens!



For Children's Mental Health Week we have focused on emotions in this room. Each child is present with different emotion faces to choose from during circle time. We then have looked at turn taking and talking about how we are feeling and why they have chosen a happy or sad face.

Many of the Mischievous Monkeys decided to dress up also during this week to express what they wanted to be!



To celebrate Chinese New Year our toddlers enjoyed painting and decorating lanterns with glitter and then hanging them up! They also enjoyed colouring their own Tiger... to celebrate the year of the Tiger!

For Valentine's Day the children enjoyed making hearts out of playdough! They also enjoyed making their Valentine's Cards.



In Mischievous Monkeys we have a new theatre area – the children have enjoyed dressing up as different characters to make up their own story! Playing parts as actors and the audience! Looking forward to seeing how this area further develops!

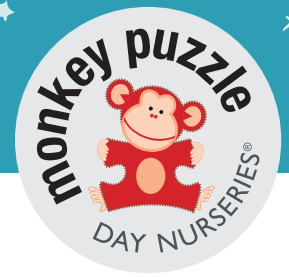
