We have been making Christmas cards, calendars and reindeer food for the children to bring home.



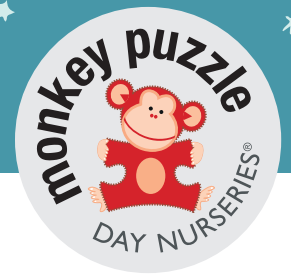
We have also had fun making our Christmas role play area and decorating our Christmas tree. We have had lots of fun with glitter, making baubles, pictures and decorations.

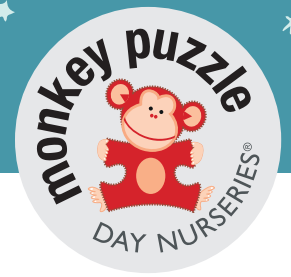
