This month we looked at VE Day, as well as joining the whole of the country to celebrate the Kings Coronation!

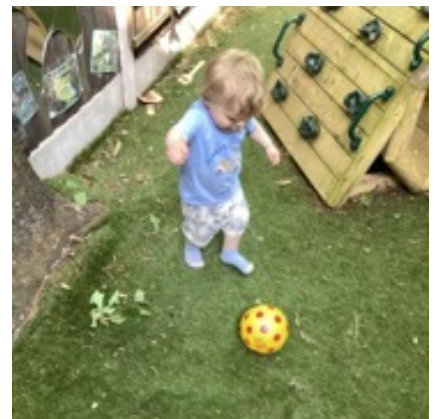
So, what have the rooms been up to this month?

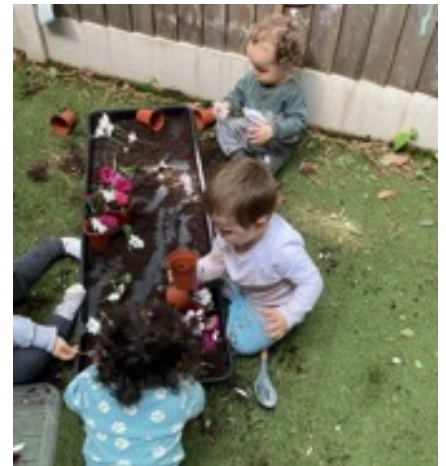

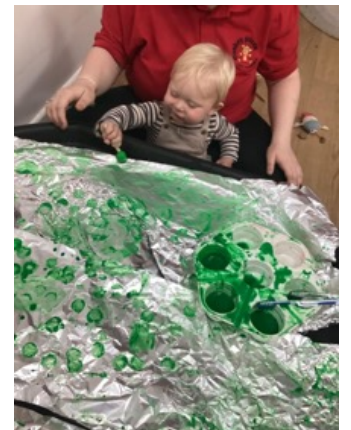

We have spoken about the different types of the plants in the greenhouse and what is growing!

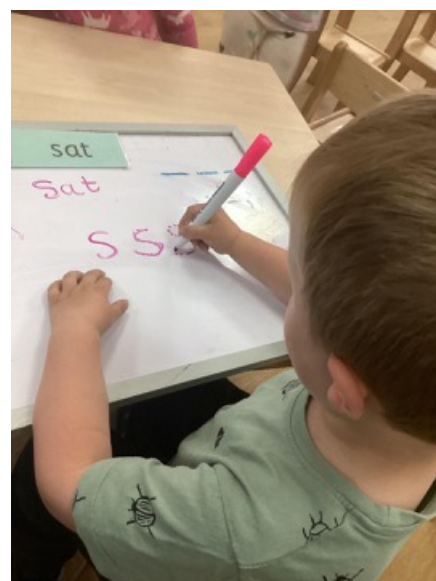

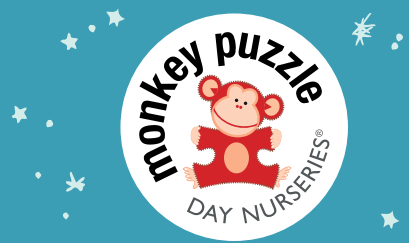


We also celebrated the Kings Coronation with fun filled activities!
