### **Cheeky Chimps**

This month the children of Cheeky Chimps have explored activities that focus on our understanding of the world area of development. The children have enjoyed various messy tray activities such as vehicles and cereal where the children have learnt to create different sounds for the car, train, and plane toys that we have.

The children have also loved creating dinosaur swamps using different types of food like mushy peas, pasta and natural resources like soil and leaves.



One of our main projects that we are starting for the summer is including different forest school activities to allow the children to play with natural resources and decorate our garden.

In the last couple of weeks, we have been creating bird feeders using pipe cleaners and cheerio's. This activity has been fantastic for the children's fine motor control skills which focused on their finger and thumb grip.









This month we have also enjoyed celebrating different themes.

We had the start of Pride month where the children were colouring rainbows.

We had national parent day where children enjoyed sticking their mummy's and daddy's inside our house that we created.







We also explored World environment day where the children were learning what can go in the ocean and what cannot.



### **Mischievous Monkeys**

This month in the toddler room the children have enjoyed activities involving dinosaurs. They have explored a variety of tuff trays with different textures to use their imagination with dinosaurs. The children had very different responses:

- "I'm feeding the dinosaur coffee".
- "I'm making a pink house".
- "I'm making dinosaur food".

Whilst the weather has been getting warmer, the children have enjoyed being in the garden, developing their physical skills...walking along the plank, walking up the stairs on the slide and climbing on the train.









Inside the nursery we attempted to complete the "we're going on a bear hunt" jigsaw!









Outside we loved listening to "we're going on a bear hunt" and then the children went on a bear hunt themselves.!

They all shouted, "we found a bear" and pointed at places where there might be some bears.

Preschool have been having a fantastic time this month. We have been exploring our emotions and talking about feelings. The children made pictures of their emotions and came out with some fantastic words including "Grumpy, excited, happy and sad".





We are now finding ways to self-regulate our emotions and feels, this is very i mportant and will help us throughout our life.







The children have also been busy exploring the water and learning new concepts such as full, half full, empty. They experimented with funnels and had a fantastic time even got a little wet whilst exploring.

We have also be en looking at number recognition and identify numbers on our fingers, the children are becoming fantastic at this. Well done pre-school.


